

COOKIES EXTENDED INFORMATION NOTICE

In accordance with Article 13 of Legislative Decree 196/2003 (Personal Data Protection Code), *Industrie Rolli Alimentari S.p.A.* (hereinafter “Data Controller”) provides you with the extended information notice relating to the cookies installed on the website <http://www.rolli.it> .

Cookies are strings of text (small files) that the sites visited by Users send to their terminal (PC, tablet, smartphone, etc.), where they are stored and sent back to the same sites that sent them during the next visit by the same User. Moreover, some of Cookies’ purposes may require Users’ consent.

THECHNICAL AND PROFILING COOKIES

Activities strictly necessary for the website operation

This website uses Cookies to save Users’ surfing session and to improve the usability of the website, for example, collecting data about website traffic levels.

Saving of preferences, optimizations and statistics

This website uses Cookies to remember Users’ choices (language and currency selection) and to ensure Users with a safe and efficient surfing and use of the website.

HOW TO CHANGE COOKIE SETTINGS?

On accessing any landing page of a website, a banner which contains a short information notice is shown to Users. If Users continue browsing by accessing any other section of the website or selecting any item of the same (e.g. in image or a link), they consent to the use of Cookies. A “technical cookie” is used to remember the users’ consent regarding Cookies.

Users may object to cookies being recorded on their hard disk by setting their browser to disable Cookies. After doing so, however, this website may not perform correctly.

Here below he can find the instruction provided by the major browsers to manage Cookies:

Microsoft Internet Explorer

1. Open Internet Explorer;
2. Click on the “Tools” button and then on “Internet Options”;
3. Select the “Privacy” tab and move the slider device to the desired privacy level (upwards to block all cookies or downwards to allow them all);
4. Then click on “Ok”.

Mozilla Firefox

1. Open Firefox;

2. Press the “Alt” key on the keyboard;
3. In the toolbar at the top of the browser, select “Tools” and then “Options”;
4. Then select the “Privacy” tab;
5. Go to “History settings” and then to “Use custom settings”;
6. Uncheck “Accept cookies from sites” and save these preferences.

Google Chrome

1. Open Google Chrome;
2. Click the “Tools” icon;
3. Select “Settings” and then “Advanced settings”;
4. Select “Content settings” under “Privacy”;
5. In the “Cookies” tab, it is possible to clear the cookies and save these preferences.

Apple Safari

1. Open Safari;
2. Choose “Preferences” in the toolbar, and then select the “Security” panel in the dialogue window that follows;
3. Under “Accept cookies” it is possible to specify whether and when Safari must save cookies from websites. For more information click on the Help button (marked with a question mark);
4. For more information on cookies that are stored on your computer, click “Show cookies”.

Art. 7 Italian Legislative Decree no. 196/2003. Rights Granted to You.

1. A data subject shall have the right to obtain confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning him exist, regardless of their being already recorded, and communication of such data in intelligible form.
2. A data subject shall have the right to be informed:
 - a. of the source of the personal data;
 - b. of the purposes and methods of processing;
 - c. of the logic applied to the processing, if the latter is carried out with the help of electronic means;
 - d. of the identification data concerning Data Controller, data processors and the representative designated as per Section 5(2);
 - e. of the entities or categories of entity to whom or which the personal data may be communicated and who or which may get to know said data in their capacity as designated representative(s) in the State's territory, data processor(s) or person(s) in charge of the processing.
3. A data subject shall have the right to obtain:
 - a. updating, rectification or, where interested therein, integration of the data;
 - b. erasure, anonymization or blocking of data that have been processed unlawfully, including data whose retention is unnecessary for the purposes for which they have been collected or subsequently processed;
 - c. certification to the effect that the operations as per letters a) and b) have been notified, as also related to their contents, to the entities to whom or which the data were communicated or disseminated, unless this requirement proves impossible or involves a manifestly disproportionate effort compared with the right that is to be protected.
4. A data subject shall have the right to object, in whole or in part,
 - a. on legitimate grounds, to the processing of personal data concerning him/her, even though they are relevant to the purpose of the collection;
 - b. to the processing of personal data concerning him/her, where it is carried out for the purpose of sending advertising materials or direct selling or commercial communication or else for the performance of market surveys.
